Our mission is to prevent child abuse by delivering the most effective educational and public awareness programs designed to identify and stop physical, emotional and sexual abuse where children live, learn and play!

COCA'S PROGRAMS:

Protect and Comfort Infants

This educational program teaches parents and caregivers of newborns about the normalcy of crying, how to soothe crying infants and warns that shaking a baby can cause brain damage, blindness or death. Practical suggestions about how to manage infant behaviors in ways that are proactive and nurturing are offered.

Personal Safety Programs

COCA staff provides a variety of child abuse/peer abuse prevention programs through presentations to children in grades Pre K-12, school personnel, and parents. Children learn abuse prevention and personal safety strategies and have opportunities to disclose current or previous abuse, neglect or bullying incidents, which often require adult intervention.

Community Education Program

As part of our community outreach efforts, COCA conducts a variety of activities to promote public awareness of child abuse and its prevention. COCA staff provides trainings, consultations, and presentations to schools, community groups, and professionals. In 2008, COCA launched a speaker series called "Kids Matter!" designed to stimulate greater public awareness about child abuse and its prevention.
