Dear Friends,

This past year, the Council on Child Abuse (COCA) continued to respond to the ever growing and evolving needs of students, parents and educators.

During the 2023-2024 school year, COCA provided safety presentations to more than 34,000 children in 1,135 classrooms at 102 schools- nearly tripling our in-classroom, student impact. This rising demand for our programs fuels our commitment to our mission.

We proudly added Safe Dating programming to our curriculum over the past school year. This program is tailored towards junior high and high school students, focusing on healthy versus unhealthy relationships, understanding consent and safe dating strategies, and giving students an opportunity in a safe environment to disclose concerns. We would not be able to continue to grow, share, or carry out our mission without the support of our incredible community.

With the aid and collaboration of our board, we remain focused on both advocacy and fundraising. Our annual Reach for the Stars event was held in April to recognize National Child Abuse Prevention Month and was undoubtedly our most successful event to date, raising over \$77,000 in support of our mission.

We thank our donors, volunteers and staff who made this year such a success.
