Donor Privacy Agreement

This Donor Privacy Agreement outlines the commitment of The Council On Child Abuse to ensuring the privacy and confidentiality of our donors' personal information.

Information Collected:

Donors are informed of what information is being collected and how it will be used through this Agreement and other communication channels.

The Council On Child Abuse may collect and maintain the following types of donor information:

- Contact Information: Names, addresses, phone numbers, and email addresses.
- Donation History: Records of contribution, including amounts and dates.
- Financial Information: Payment details, such as credit card information, for processing donations.

Use of Information:

The information collected will be used for the following purposes:

- Processing and acknowledging donations.
- Providing donors with receipts and updates on The Council On Child Abuse's activities.
- Internal record-keeping and reporting.
- Complying with legal and regulatory requirements.

Privacy and Security:

The Council On Child Abuse is committed to protect the privacy and security of donor information. All reasonable measures will be taken to prevent unauthorized access, disclosure, or attention of donor information. Talbert House employs security measures to protect donors' personal information, including encryption and restricted access to sensitive data.

Third-Party Disclosures:

The Council On Child Abuse does not sell, trade, or share donor information with third parties. Limited exceptions may include trusted service providers who assist in donation processing or communications, provided they agree to maintain the confidentiality of the information.

Donor Choice:

Donors have the right to:

- Opt-out of receiving communications from The Council On Child Abuse.
- Request to remain anonymous in The Council On Child Abuse publications.
- Access their personal information and request corrections.

Choice:
